HOW DO PENGUINS SCIENCE STAY WARM?

You'll need 200g Lard Latex gloves Ice Water Medium sized container Stop watch

Instructions



Half fill the container with water and ice. Place a latex glove on both hands. Cover one glove with lard. Place both hands in the icy water. Which hand feels cold the fastest?

The lard acts as an insulator protecting your hands from the cold of the icy water, just like penguin blubber!

Challenge

Find out why penguin's feet don't freeze.

Penguins have a thick layer of blubber and thick feathers to help keep them warm.
