Extras - balloon, tissue paper Cut the tissue paper up into small pieces and blow up the balloon.

Can you help me tidy up the paper using a clever elf trick?

Rub the balloon on your hair and hold it over the tissue paper. Watch what happens!

Elf explanation

Rubbing the balloon on your hair charges it with static electricity. This attracts the paper making it jump up to the balloon.

Cheeky elf trick

Rub the balloon on your hair again and put it against a wall.

The balloon will stick to the wall until the static charge wears off.

What's inside an elf?


Extras - paper, pens

Don't forget to label it!


Boiled or not?
