## **CLEAN COINS**

## You'll need

Vinegar Salt Small Bowl Copper coins



Place a teaspoon of salt into the bowl.

Add about 50ml of vinegar and stir to dissolve.

Place the coins in the vinegar and salt solution and leave for about 30 minutes.

When the coins look shiny, take them out of the vinegar and rinse with water.

## Why does it work?

Copper coins don't stay shiny because the copper reacts with oxygen in the air to form copper oxide, which is a dull greenish-grey colour.

When you mix salt (sodium chloride) with vinegar (acetic acid), sodium acetate and hydrogen chloride form. Hydrogen chloride is an acid which works well at rapidly cleaning the surface of the copper coin, leaving it beautifully shiny and removing the oxide.
